# Consensus to identify terrorists in DU

Major student organisations at a meeting with acting Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University on Tuesday decided to prepare list of terrorists of their respective organisations and declare all listed terrorists persona non grata in the University with a view to maintaining congenial academic atmosphere on the campus.

The meeting was attended by ruling party's student front Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), BNP's student wing Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO), a conglomeration of

eight left-leaning student organisations. It was held at the VC's office at 1 p.m. with Vice-Chancellor Prof. Shahiduddin Ahmed in the chair.

Meanwhile, Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal alleged that at least 60 JCD members were driven out by BCL (S-P) from Mohsin Hall of Dhaka University on Monday night.

The JCD leaders said the terrorists of Chhatra League (S-P) forcibly drove out their leaders and activists from the hall when they tried to enter the hall.

The Chhatra Dal leaders demanded necessary measures against those

terrorists and reinstatement of their leaders and activists at their respective seats.

In another incident Md. Abdul Aziz, Publicity Secretary of JSD (Inu) backed Bangladesh Chhatra League (K-C) was reportedly assaulted by the activists of BCL (S-P) at Mohsin Hall.

On the other hand the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which was signed by different student organisations to bring back congenial atmosphere on the Dhaka University campus has virtually been ineffective

as the known terrorists of both Chhatra Dal and Chhatra League were verifying the identity cards of the genuine students in the place of hall administration at the gate of different halls of the university.

As per MOU the verification of identity cards by the hall administration will continue for 15 days to make all the dormitories of the university free from non-students and terrorists but the hall administrations were not seen checking the identity cards of the students at most of the halls of the university on Tuesday.

### BCL rally

Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) brought out a procession and held a rally on the Dhaka University campus, on Tuesday protesting the threat on the life of Sheikh Hasina by some BNP leaders.

Addressing the rally the BCL leaders said any threat on the life of Sheikh Hasina would be foiled by Chhatra League members.

The BCL (S-P) leaders also expressed their firm determination to maintain a peaceful atmosphere on the university campus. They said the BCL members were always against

the terrorism and they would extend their helping hands to the government in stamping out terrorism from the campus and society.

The rally held at the Aparajayo Bangla of Dhaka University was addressed, among others, by Bahadur Bepary, Abdul Woadud Khokon and Sazzad Hossain.

Meanwhile, BCL (S-P) General Secretary Ishaq Ali Khan Panna at a rally on Tuesday condemned the threat on the life of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina by some BNP leaders from a rally and said BCL members would protect Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina even at the cost of their lives.

The rally held at the premises of Brahmanbaria Government College was addressed by Shahanur Islam, Shahajahan Alam Saju, Dilara Harun, Amanul Haq Senu and Farhad Hossain, among others, says a Press release.
