

Headmaster assaults gurdian for not paying donation

The headmaster of Dhania A K High Scholl along with some other staff members physically assaulted a guardian of a female student who obtained 'A' grade in the SSC exam this year.

According to sources, Fouzia Islam, daughter of Mohammed Chand Meah, resident of Dhania achieved grade 'A' in SSC this year. Being inspired by her daughter's result, her father wanted to admit Fouzia Islam at city's Viquaartunessa High School

and College. Yesterday (Saturday) was the last date for submitting the form for admission test.

Chand Meah told the reporters that he went to Dhania School several times and repeatedly requested the Headmaster and members of the School Committee for issuing N-O-C and 'letter of appreciation' for her daughter's admission in Viquaartunessa High School.

Surprisingly, the headmaster Selim Bhuiyan who is the presi-

dent of School Teachers Association and some members of the School Managing Committee refused to give the NOC and other relating papers.

It is alleged that Selim Bhuiyan demanded a huge amount of donation for the school. But being refused to get the money, he became very angry and asked the concerned authority not to give any documents in favour of Fouzia without his permission.

On Saturday, Selim and Chand Meah were locked in an altercation when the school authority refused to give the documents including transfer certificate of Fouzia.

Sources said, Chand Meah received serious injuries when at one stage, Selim along with some members of the school committee beat him mercilessly. Later, some locals rescued Chand Meah and sent him to a clinic for treatment.

Meanwhile, hundreds of local people gathered there and demanded an exemplary punishment of the accused persons including Selim Bhuiyan.

High officials of police and other law-enforcing agencies rushed to the spot to maintain law and order situation. Besides, senior officials of Education Ministry and Deputy Commissioner of Dhaka went to the spot.

The officials and the school committee sat in a meeting to settle the matter, but failed due to severe agitation by the local people.

Later, a case was filed with Shyampur police station accusing Selim Bhuiyan and some of his accomplices.
