

DU contradicts Press reports

The Dhaka University (DU) authorities on Friday contradicted some reports appeared in different dailies and termed those as motivated, unacceptable and not based on facts, reports BSS.

The reports were published in the dailies on Friday on the incidents that took place following police raid in Shamsunnahar Hall of the university.

In a statement, the DU authorities said that they had earlier directed the hall authorities repeat-

edly to take effective measures to oust the outsiders who were staying in the hall illegally. But, the former provost of Shamsunnahar Hall failed to take any action against them.

The statement said that without taking actions against the outsiders staying in the hall, the then provost sent a list of three or four outsiders belonging to JCD to the authorities. But, she did not submit list of outsiders belonging to Chhatra League.

It is learnt that the then provost gave permission to the JCD leaders to stay in the hall to please them for her own interest, it added.

The authorities also rejected another report that stated the Vice-Chancellor did not take any action against the JCD leaders to please the government.

Referring to another news item, it said that there was no information to the authorities or the transport section of the university that anybody had left the VC's resident in a university microbus on Wednesday.
