DU denies male police action in SN Hall

Dhaka University authorities denied male police having entered into Shamsunnahar Hall Tuesday midnight and misbehaved with the girl students, reports UNB.

In a three-page statement Thursday night, the DU authorities said: "Policewomen were deployed at the authority's request and police high officials were in charge of directing the female police."

However, the statement again admitted that the police officials entered into the hall to direct the policewomen in the action prompted by troubles inside the dorm amid agitation by two rival groups of students.

Four assistant proctors of the university who were on the scene also submitted in the statement that there were no policemen engaged in the operation.

"Police personnel didn't commit any obscenities with the female students," the DU statement said quoting the assistant proctors.
