



DU teachers condemn police excesses

The Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) will bring out a silent procession and abstain from work from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. today (Sunday) in protest against police excesses in Shamsunnahar Hall (SN) on the night of July 23, reports BSS.

The decisions were taken at a requisition meeting of DUTA held in its office Saturday evening with its President Prof. Abul Khair in the chair.

The meeting condemned the police raid in the SN Hall and put forward a seven-point demands for immediate implementation.

The demands included withdrawal of police from the campus; exemplary punishment to the responsible persons; compensation for students as well as proper treatment of injured ones; deterring recurrence of such incident in future; stopping police raid in dormitories without permission of the hall authorities; formation of new investigation committee and accepting responsibility by university authorities of the incidents.

Prof. Sharifullah Bhuiyan, General Secretary of DUTA, conducted the meeting.
