

IU closed for indefinite period

KUSHTIA, Nov 7:—Islamic University was closed today for an indefinite period apparently to avoid possible clashes between two belligerent student groups, reports UNB.

The decision to close the university was taken in an emergency meeting tonight (Saturday night), with Vice-Chancellor Prof M Quaisuddin in the chair.

Earlier, Section 144 was imposed on the campus for 12 hours till 6 pm as Islami Chhatra Shibir and Chhatra League had called for rallies.
