Decision on admission

Govt's call not to be misled by statements of vested quarters

The government has urged the students and the guardians not to be misled by the statements of the vested quarters regarding government decision on admission into the colleges and equivalent educational institutions and into the universities from this year on the basis of SSC and HSC examination results, reports BSS.

An official handout issued here Sunday night said the decision on admission was taken at a meeting between the government and the University Grants Commission (UGC), vice-chancellors of the universities, principals of the government and non-government

colleges and the leaders of college teachers association held recently.

The decision had already been acclaimed widely by the different newspapers and the guardians, the handout added.

The government had taken this decision to solve the problem of uncertainty regarding admission of the talented students and to protect the students seeking admission and their guardians from the economic and psychological pressure and harassment caused by exorbitant admission fees, high cost of admission forms as well as commercially based coaching for admission.

Besides, as result of introduction of computer for publication of SSC and HSC examination results in the last two years, the examination system has become more objective and free from corruption, the handout further said.
