



Teacher shortage in Sherpur Govt. College

SHERPUR, Dec. 1:—Sherpur Government College has been facing manifold problems like shortage of teachers, lack of furniture and science apparatus, scarcity of water supply and recreational facilities, reports UNB.

According to informed sources the college is now running with 1,200 students but there are only 33 teachers out of 56. There one no Vice-Principal and demonstrator since a decade last.

A good number of teachers are residing in the college hostels owing to shortage of staff quarters. The hostel building is now in a dilapidated condition and may collapse any day, some of them said.

Books are scarce in the library located in a very small room which is unable to meet the requirement of the students.

Lack of sitting accommodation, recreational facilities and transport stated to be the other problems being encountered by the college.

The students as well as the local guardians have appealed to the government to take necessary steps for solving these problems soon.
