

Varsity college to be set up in Gazipur

President Hussain Muhammad Ershad has asked the Education Ministry to take steps to convert the Bhawal Badre Alam College into a university college. Prime Minister Kazi Zafar Ahmed informed the Jatiya Sangsad Monday night, reports BSS.

Replying to a query from Mr. Hasin Uddin Sarkar, MP and Chairman of Gazipur District Council, whether there was any instruction from the President with regard to the demand of the inhabitants of Gazipur the Prime Minister said that President Ershad had also issued instructions to convert the Islamic University building at Gazipur into a most modern 200-bed hospital.

Members from both the Treasury and Opposition benches welcomed the two announcements by thumping their desks in the house.

Kazi Zafar told the Members that the proposed 200-bed hospital would ultimately be developed
