

Army camp  
set up at  
DU gymnasium

The Army, during its anti-terrorism crackdown across the country, have set up a camp inside the Dhaka University Gymnasium, reports UNB.

About 300 army personnel are staying in their camp at the gymnasium, where students are now barred from doing physical exercises.

Officers and employees of the gymnasium are, however, allowed to enter by showing ID cards.

Meanwhile, many student leaders and cadres, believed involved in criminal activities, have already left the university dormitories fearing possible operation by the army.

Students, who completed their education from the University but are staying in the dormitories for a long time, also left to avoid any harassment.

Army is yet to conduct any operation in the halls, but their presence on the campus has created a sense of panic among the general students.

When contacted, DU Proctor ASM Atiqur Rahman told UNB that if any operation is needed in the dormitories, it would be done with permission from the university authorities.
