Military Collegiate School opens in Fultala

KHULNA, Feb. 17:—Bangladesh Army as part of its nation building activities established a unique English medium school Military Collegiate School Fultala (MCSP) near Khulna, says an ISPR Press release.

Education Minister Dr M Osman Farruk inaugurated the newly established institution amidst attractive natural surroundings of the Beeldakatia under Fultala upazila in the Khulna district.

It has been learnt that the MCSP differs from Cadet Colleges or Cantonment Public School or Colleges run by the army. Since English has become very important in the national and international area as well as in case of higher education, the MCSP was established to meet the demand of the time. This type of institutions are there in Pakistan, India and England.

It has also learnt that the MCSP would introduce a new dimension in the present education system. The institution would pursue a powerful way of instructions that would suit the present time and enable its students to overcome the shortcomings of procuring important profession and posts as well as pursuing higher studies abroad. Besides, the MCSP would provide training on military etiquette and qualities of military leadership and physical fitness.
