

APSU demands trial of Ershad, allies

The All-Party Student Unity (APSU) leaders Thursday reaffirmed that their alliance would not fall apart till democracy is established and their demands fulfilled, reports UNB.

Addressing a rally, DUCSU VP Amanullah Aman appealed to all to maintain peace and order so that the "enemies of democracy" do not get any scope to foil hard-earned victory over autocracy.

Held at the Aparajeya Bengla, the rally was also addressed by Chhatra League (H-A) President Habibur Rahman Habib, Chhatra League (N-S) President Nazmul Huq Prodhan and Chhatra Union President Mostafizur Rahman Babul.

The student leaders said Ershad and his allies would not be allowed to escape their trial for misdeeds.

They demanded capital punishment of certain agency men for their in-

volvement in the killing of Dr. Shamsul Alam Khan Milon and APSU activists as well as masterminding campus violence.

The APSU rally also demanded punishment of the killers Rafiqul Islam Dulal who was killed Wednesday at Rajshahi. The student leader was killed in firing on a victory procession passing by the residence of a state minister.

Earlier, APSU went in a silent procession to the grave of Dr. Milon at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital premises and offered wreaths.
