Call to remove irregularities in BAU

MYMENSINGH, Dec. 27 : The Bangladesh Agricultural University unit of All-Party Students' Unity (APSU) urged authorities to promulgate a democratic ordinance" for the university in the light of the University Ordinance of 1973, reports UNB.

In a memorandum to the Presidential Adviser for Education, the APSU leaders of the Agricultural University at Mymensingh said opportunities of seeking knowledge freely were hampered due to the absence of a democratic ordinance for the University.

The memorandum alleged that the university administration had resorted to large-scale irregularities and mal-practices in "autocratic style" and also played a role in the former regime's bid to suppress the anti-autocratic movement.

The APSU leaders also demanded resignation of Vice Chancellor Prof. Muhammad Asadut Rahman who, they said, was a close associate of ousted President Ershad and was appointed illegally in absence of a democratic ordinance.
