Sophia Mahila College gets DU recognition

MADARIPUR, Dec 11:—Professor Addul Mannan, Vice-Chancellor, University of Dhaka graced the inaugural ceremony of the Administrative Building of Madaripur Sophia Mahila College as the chief guest on December 7.

Presided over by Kazi Nasirul Islam, Deputy Commissioner, Madaripur, the meeting was addressed by Md. Abdus Sattar, Principal of Madaripur Sophia Mahila College, Dr. Aminur Rahman, Proctor, D.U., Md.
