



Closure of medical colleges ordered

The Government by an order on Saturday closed down all the medical colleges of the country for 30 days and asked the medical students to leave the hostels by 4 p.m. on Saturday.

A Dhaka Medical College source said the Government has ordered closure of the Medical Colleges in view of the continuous strike by the medical students and in-service doctors.

Leaders of the central joint bodies of the medical students and in-service doctors, Bangladesh Chhatra Union and Bangladesh Chhatra League (Shirin-Mustaq) in separate statements on Saturday strongly resented the government order closing all medical colleges for one month. They also resented the order asking the medical students to vacate their hostels.

Kendrio Medical Chhatra Oikkya Parishad (Central Medical Students Unity) demanded of the Government to accept 6-point demand of the medical
