Dental College employees, students clash

More than three persons were injured in a clash between some employees and students of Dental College at Dhaka Medical College premises on Tuesday morning.

Some students said that the college was closed about one and a half months ago over a dispute between the students and the authorities. But the authority suddenly opened the hospital and the college without resolving the dispute on Tuesday. The authorities allegedly used a section of employees to run the institution ignoring the interest of the students.

Receiving the news of opening of hospital and the college a group of students brought out a procession on the college campus at about 11 a.m. The students chanted slogans demanding solution to the persisting conflict between the authorities and the students. At one stage a section of hospital employees chased the demonstrating students and blasted several bombs leaving at least three persons injured.

The injured persons are identified as Ashish Kumar, Nabarun and Nahid. They were given first aid.
