DUCSU slates role of V-C

Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) in a meeting on Tuesday castigated the role of the Vice-Chancellor in maintaining peace and discipline on the campus. The Vice-Chancellor, who is the president of DUCSU, was not present at the meeting. Vice-President Sultan Mohammed Mansoor Ahmed was also absent from the meeting as he is staying outside Dhaka.

The meeting in a special resolution on Vice-Chancellor said that the incident of February 25 in which a student leader was killed has occurred due to deliberate indifference of the Vice-Chancellor and conspiracy of the Government. The meeting held the University administration, especially the Vice-Chancellor responsible for the killing of Shahidul Islam Chunnu.

The meeting observed that instead of taking actions against the hooligans, the Vice-Chancellor used them to safeguard his own interests.

It said that the Vice-Chancellor did not pay heed to 28-point demands of DUCSU which was placed before him for resisting armed terrorism in the University. The meeting felt that the present Vice-Chancellor had lost all moral obligations in resisting terrorism on the campus.

In another resolution, the meeting demanded immediate reopening of the University. The meeting

observed that the University could not remain closed for months together for the cause of armed hooliganism by a handful number of hoodlums. The meeting demanded necessary steps to take examinations in the month of Ramjan. The meeting also sought security measure for the campus inhabitants. It demanded immediate meeting of the "University Education Environment Council".

The DUCSU meeting condemned the Vice-Chancellor for not giving permission to the sports teams take part in the inter-university hockey, national table tennis and national athletics competitions. It demanded withdrawal of the ban on the sports teams.

Presided over the Chowdhury Altaf Al Azam Parvez, the meeting was attended by eight members out of 20 member committee of DUCSU including General Secretary Mosh-taq Hossain, Assistant General Secretary Nasirudduza and Cultural Secretary Ashok Taru Karmaker.

DUCSU will meet again soon to take a decision about the Vice-Chancellor.
