BAU teachers not to take part in admission test activities

Teachers of Bangladesh Agricultural University will boycott the activities in the ensuing admission test if the question-setting teacher is not relieved from his responsibility immediately, says a Press release.

According to a decision, the teachers of the Agricultural University will stay away from activities relating to admission test to be held tomorrow (May 15) unless the teacher, who is entrusted with the job of question-setting, is relieved from his responsibility.

The President of Sonali Group, a teachers' body of BAU Prof Dr Khondaker Sirajul Islam and General Secretary Prof M Borhanuddin said, the teacher who has been given the task of setting question has a candidate, who is his nearest relative.

They also said, according to the rules of the university a teacher having any relative candidate, must refrain from all activities of admission test and should earlier inform the university of the matter.

But, teachers of Sonali Group said, this year the question setter teacher has violated the rules of the university.

They also alleged that the university did not take any step despite the fact that they were informed of the matter earlier.
