

SCJ demands implementation

CUCSU rejects probe body report

CHITTAGONG, July 13:—Chittagong University Central Students Union (CUCSU) Vice-President M. Nazimuddin Saturday said the one-man commission report on the December 22 incident was not acceptable and that the campus would have to be cleared of a particular terrorist group before reopening the university, reports BSS.

He demanded immediate arrest of the killers of student leader Faruquzzaman Faruk and armed activists of a student organisation who, he claimed, had besieged the university for long seven months.

Addressing a Press conference at the Press Club here, Mr. Nazimuddin in his six-page written statement narrated different incidents of the campus during the past seven months and blamed Islami Chhatra Shibir and a section of teachers for creating a chaotic and unhealthy atmosphere leading to the closure of the university. He warned that the university would not be allowed to reopen unless terrorists and killers of the student leader were arrested.

He said CUCSU would continue to strive for protecting 1973 Uni-

versity Ordinance and resist tooth and nail any attempt to violate it. The democratically elected present Vice-Chancellor cannot be removed, he said.

The CUCSU leader said, we want peace, a congenial academic atmosphere and a terror-free campus for pursuing our studies. He hoped that the government would not take any undemocratic step in finding a solution to the long-drawn crisis of Chittagong University.
