Teacher shortage in 150 schools in Dinajpur

DINAJPUR, Nov 13:—About 150 secondary schools in Dinajpur district have been beset with manifold

problems hampering education. Classes in some schools are held the open sky as the school buildings damaged in the natural calamities are yet to be repaired.

The schools have been facing problems like shortage of teachers, furniture and accommodation, scarcity of water supply and absence of playground. Most of the school buildings are in deplorable condition.

In the absence of playground extra curriculum activities are being hampered in many schools.

These schools established under the local initiatives have been facing fund shortage as most of them did not get government application.

Besides shortage of teachers in these schools is a common phenomenon.

Local people have urged the authorities concerned to take necessary steps to solve the problems of the schools.
