

One dies hearing arrest of son by army in Chandpur

A 50-year old man died of cardiac failure at Jola Tetuiya village in Kachua upazila in Chandpur district after he came to know that the army-led joint forces arrested his son and nephew on Sunday.

The man named as Adam Ali fell sick and died instantly beside a canal near his residence at about 7 am when he heard that the army troops held his son Bashir Ahmed and nephew Mosharraf Hossain with arms and ammunition from his house.

BDR personnel detained notorious criminal Salim Mridha alias Pahari Selim from Jigatala belt area in Dubaura upazila under Mymensingh district on Sunday when he was trying to flee the country crossing the border.

In Sirajganj, the joint forces arrested five persons including Krishak League president of Ulapara upazila Khorshed Alam and ICD leader Shahin from Tarash upazila on Saturday.
