

## Cancel result of 20th BCS exams: Khaleda

Accusing the authorities of giving "large-scale" appointment of Awami League activists to various cadres, BNP chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia on Wednesday demanded immediate cancellation of the results of the 20th BCS examinations, reports UNB.

In a statement, she alleged that pro-Awami League elements in the Public Service Commission (PSC) appointed 416 BCL and AL leaders, activists and supporters to various cadres under the 20th BCS ex-

aminations.

"It manifests their shameless favouritism," she said adding, "300 out of 416 were appointed to the Admin Cadre from Awami supporters while 116 to the Police Cadre."

"PSC has not only lost its dignity and reputation as a constitutional institution, meritorious students have also been deprived of their rights by their misdeeds," the former premier observed.
