

Accommodation problem in Chuadanga pry. schools acute

CHUADANGA, Feb. 14.—The I.D.A. Project had a major role to develop primary education of the country.

In order to ease the accommodation problem of the students of primary schools of the district one tin shed room was constructed in each of the 249 Primary Schools.

When contacted the D.P.E.O. Chuadanga, told this correspondent that the problem of accommodation of large scale admission in Primary Schools has aggravated owing to withdrawal of the project.

The D.P.E.O. further told me that other districts have three or four storied buildings to accommodate a large number of students but this district has no such building to ease

the burden of additional students.

It is further disclosed by him that all the Primary Schools of the district have acute problem to accommodate extra students on admission.

The D.P.E.O. suggested that this big problem may be solved by constructing multi-storied buildings.

I have visited Primary Schools of the town and saw myself many tiny tots are taking lessons from their teachers sitting on the floor of the verandah of the school buildings.

This problem can be solved by constructing adequate number of buildings or multi-storied buildings. This has become a must to solve accommodation problem in the Primary schools.
