### DU Syndicate urges students to show restraint

The Dhaka University Syndicate in an emergency meeting on Thursday urged the feuding student organisations to refrain from further clashes following Wednesday's incident. It reiterated the call to members of the law-enforcing agencies to arrest any body found on the campus with weapons.

Presided over by Professor Moniruzzaman Mia, Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University, the meeting reviewed the situation arising out of Wednesday's gun battle between supporters of rival student organisations.

The Vice-Chancellor apprised the members of the Syndicate about the incident in which Mustafizur Rahman Jahan, a student of Zia Hall received bullet wound in the second floor of Surya Sen Hall. Shahidul Islam Shahid, a student of S.M. Hall was stabbed while a number of students including girls were also injured during clashes, he said.

The clashes occurred between supporters of Chhatra League and Chhatra Dal, the meeting felt.

The police also undertook an intensive search in S.M. Hall, Sgt. Zahirul Huq Hall and Surya Sen Hall but could not recover any weapon.

Meanwhile, different student organisations including Student Unity Forum, Samajtantrik Chhatra Front, Bangladesh Chhatra League condemned the incident.
