## Call-to eradicate illiteracy

KISHOREGANJ, Aug 16.— State Minister for Public Works and Urban Development, Dr. Fazlul Karim called upon the people to rid the country of the curse of illiteracy having been imbued with the second phase of revolution of President Ziaur Rahman, reports DSS.
