

BTA meet resents school timing from 9 am to 5 pm

Bangladesh Shikkak Samity (Bangladesh Teachers' Association) in a meeting held on Wednesday expressed its resentment over and rejected the government decision to run schools from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. everyday.

The meeting demanded payment of 100% salary of teachers and staff by the government. The meeting also demanded Festival Bonus and House-Rent like that of the teachers and staff of government schools.

The meeting also urged the government to cancel manpower structure policy and pay the facilities of Welfare Trust by September 30 and also to pay the next scale to the Head Masters and Assistant Head Masters.

The BTA meeting called upon the government to accept their demand, otherwise, they will hold a grand rally of teachers in Dhaka to realise demands.
