Student leaders vow to continue movement

NARSINGDI, Nov. 16:—All Party Student Unity, Narjsngdi unit held a rally at Sutapatty of Narsingdi Bazar Friday afternoon.

Presided over by Mr. Asadul Haque Khasrej the rally was addressed, among others, by Amanullah aman, VP, DUCSU, Habibur Rahman Habib, president, Bangladesh Chhatra League, Nazmul Haque Pradhan, President, Bangladesh Chhatra League (JSD), Khairul Kabir Khoikan, G.S. DUCSU, Nazimuddowla Chowdhury, G.S. Chhatra Union, and Noor Mohammad Bakul, G.S. Chhatra Maitree.

DUCSU VP Amanullah Aman in his address said the students community of the country has taken fresh vow to unseat the present government by December 16. He urged the members of the law enforcing agencies to remain neutral during the movement.
