



New BAU V-C takes over

Professor Dr. Muhammed Hussain, a distinguished educationist and scientist of international repute took over as new Vice-Chancellor of the Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU).

Born in August 16, 1939, Dr Hussain comes of a noble Muslim family of the village Mahmudabad at Barabkund under Sitakund thana of Chittagong district. He obtained his M.Sc. degree in 1960 from the University of Dhaka securing first class and undertook higher studies and research in Biochemistry at the Texas A&M University, USA where he obtained Ph.D degree in 1967.

Professor Hussain is married and has two daughters and one son. He is the second son of Moulvi Emdadul Haque and Mrs. Hazera Khatun.

Earlier, the Vice-Chancellor along with the audience condoled the death of two BAU students Md. Kamal Hussain and Ranjit Biswas Apu who were killed on November 9 last and prayed for the salvation of the departed souls and one minute silence was observed as mark of respect wearing black badges.
