

Parents demand reopening of BUET soon

The Guardians of students of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) urged the university authorities to reopen it immediately.

"Re-open BUET immediately, after ensuring congenial atmosphere on the campus," Nurjahan Begum, a guardian of BUET student called upon the authorities saying that such unscheduled closure will destroy the academic life of her son.

Guardians of the BUET wing of the Bangladesh Abhibhabak Parishad (BAP) made the demand at a press conference at the Dhaka University Journalists' Association (DUJA) office on Saturday.

They also demanded announcement of the fresh examination schedule and the study leave as part of preparation for the examination.

Nurjahan Begum read out the written statement at the press conference.

Among others Habibur Rahman Bhuiyan, father of Sony who was killed by the terrorists on the BUET campus, education affairs secretary of the Nagarik Samaj Nahid Roksana were present at the press conference.

The guardians said the BUET authorities have developed a disease to shut down the university.

without giving solution to the problems. This is a kind of ill attempt on the part of the authorities to cover up their failures.

They further said the demand to defer the examination by the students and the rigid stance for not shifting the examination schedule by the authorities resulted in the clash, ransacking of the university and ultimate closure of the institution-----all these demonstrate irresponsibility on the part of the BUET authorities.

They claimed that the stalemate at the BUET was ruining students' education life and demanded immediate measures to bring an end to this stalemate.

The parents also demanded to form a committee to investigate the incident and punish those
