Student-police clash in JN Hall seven injured

Seven resident students were injured seriously in the Jagannath Hall of Dhaka University in a clash with police on Tuesday night.

Police, on receipt of information that Ovi one of the alleged killers of Dr. Milon, has taken shelter in Jagannath Hall of Dhaka University, cordoned off the Hall at about 10 p.m. on Tuesday.

As four to five rounds of gunshots

were fired from inside the hall, police lobbed a few teargas shells and then tried to enter the hall.

The VP and GS and some other resident students of the Hall tried to resist their entry. As a result a clash between the police and students ensued in which over 20 students were injured.

Our DMCH correspondent adds: Seven seriously injured students including VP and GS of Jagannath Hall Students Union were admitted to the DMCH at 11 p.m. They are: Shubhash Singha Roy V.P. Bimal Krishna Mallik GS of the Hall Union received head injuries from rifle butt. Moazzem, Ananda, Saroj, Jiban and Swapan received injuries from beating.
