Panchbibi Girls High School in grip of problems

JOYPURHAT (Panchbibi), Sept. 16:

The Panchbibi Govt N.M. Girls High School is beset with manifold problems affecting the education of the students. The classrooms are too small in comparison with the need of students. The furniture of the classroom, headmistress' room, laboratories and teachers common room are inadequate, it is observed.

There is no blackboard in the classroom. Teachers commonroom, classroom and science building has no electric fan. There is no typewriter machine and cyclostyle machine to run the normal activities in the school.

One post of aya and one post of librarian are lying vacant for the last few years. There is an old model latrine and a tubewell in the school which can't supply sufficient water. There is no boundary wall of the school. The school has no auditorium for holding cultural functions and other extra curricular activities.

There is no assistant headmistress in the school. The post of English, Mathematics, Islam Dharma, Hindu Dharma teachers and physical instructor are lying vacant for the last few years affecting the normal academic atmosphere, it is reported.

A teacher of arts subject is appointed in the school 2 years back and is now serving in Dinajpur Boys High School under deputation, it is alleged.

The total number of students of the school is around 550. The number of teachers is 13 including headmistress. The school needs more teachers to run it smoothly.
