### APSU closes Islamic varsity V.C's office

ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY (Kush-tia), Feb. 18:—Islami Chhātra Shibir today Saturday put the office of the Islamic University Vice-Chancellor under lock and key demanding his resignation, cancellation of "Illegal" admission and appointment of a neutral registrar, reports UNB.

All-Party Student Unity (APSU) also observed a three-day strike at the university from February 11 demanding the VC's resignation.

On February 14, the APSU also stuck a poster at the gate of the VC's office, that read "the VC office has been locked up."

Since then, Vice-Chancellor MA Hamid did not turn up at his office.

All the student groups brought out processions on the campus and held rallies today (Saturday) on the issue.
