Varsity admn allegedly influenced DUTA poll

A section of the teachers of Dhaka University alleged that, the BNP-Jamat backed present university administration had appointed some 200 partisan teachers to influence the DUTA election held on Saturday.

The BNP-Jamaat backed "White Panel" won the election bagging 9 major posts including President, Vice-President, joint-secretary and Treasurer.

They alleged that the BNP-Jamaat backed university administrations created pressure upon the young teachers asking them to
