BAU teacher threatened by students

Three students of Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) threatened to kill a teacher of the university if he does not give pass marks to one of their mates in the examination, reports UNB.

Dr Shahajan Ali, Professor of Agro Chemistry Department, wrote a letter to the Vice-Chancellor about the incident. He said three students came to his house on Friday noon when he was watching India-Pakistan cricket match.

They put pressure on Dr Ali to pass one of their friends. He could identify two students as Arif and Munir of Masters Degree of his Department. The third student who was the examinee was unknown to the Professor.

Dr Ali said Arif tried to bring out his revolver from his pocket and warned that they would kill him if does not comply with their instruction.

In his letter to the Vice-Chancellor, Dr Ali said as a teacher he cannot perform his duty and is suffering from insecurity. He urged the university authorities to take appropriate security measures for the teachers and stern actions against the culprits.
