

DU urged to withdraw additional fees

Leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League (M-I) at a rally on Saturday called upon the students of Dhaka University to raise voice against the enhancement of fees for mark-sheet and certificate and urged the authorities to withdraw the additional fees.

Addressing the rally at the feet of Aparajeo Bangla, BCL leaders said that university authorities have increased the fees from Taka 30 to 50 for each mark-sheet and Taka 100 to 200 for each certificate which may create economic hardship to the poor students.

Criticising the Government for not taking any initiative to reduce price of educational accessories, they said that the Government has failed to give any solution to the problems of the student community during its two years in power.

They urged the Government to implement the ten-point demands of students.

Meanwhile, Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO) brought out a procession and held a rally on the opening day of the university on Saturday demanding implementation of the ten-point demands of students.

Leaders of GCO called upon the students to come forward to establish a campus free from terrorism.
