Student leaders meet V-C

Campus situation reviewed

A joint meeting of Dhaka University authorities and student leaders in Dhaka on Saturday reviewed the campus situation and renewed their resolve not to shelter the terrorists, says UNB.

The meeting, chaired by Vice Chancellor Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed and attended by the Proctor and Assistant Proctors, decided not to support any student or outsider involved in any activity contrary to the university rules.

The student leaders agreed that a joint meeting of the student organisations will decide on action against any organisation under whose umbrella terrorist activities will take place, said a DU Press release.

The meeting decided that the student leaders will meet the Vice

Chancellor once and their respective hall provosts twice a month.

It also decided to ensure legal rights of students, their stay in the hall and participation in classes and examinations.

The meeting resolved that all student organisations will conduct their activities in a democratic way and they will not raise any slogan or issue any statement derogatory to national level leaders.

It decided that law enforcing agencies will be allowed to take action against crimes which are punishable under the law and investigation or trial of which are beyond the capacity of the university authorities.

The meeting condoled the death of Kamrul Islam Bulbul, a student of the university, on the campus on August 1 and conveyed sympathy to his family members.
