DUTA demands
steps against
campus
terrorism

The Executive Committee of the Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) at a meeting on Monday expressed concern over the movement of armed youths on campus in presence of police and urged the government and the University authorities to ensure security of teachers and officials by taking measures against the terrorists.

The meeting, held at the University Club with DUTA President Prof Shahadat Ali in the chair, said that terrorists were staging rehearsal of arms at Arts Faculty premises in presence of police and apprehended

that there was a possibility of another armed shoot-out. But the University authorities and the government were not taking measures against them. The meeting said adding that their silent role had pushed the overall campus situation into uncertainty.

The meeting said that the government and the university authorities would be held responsible if any untoward incident occurred after resumption of classes today (Tuesday).

The meeting further urged the authorities to ensure the security of Journalism Department Chairman and DUTA General Secretary Dr Arefin Siddique in view of threat by armed terrorists.
