

DUTA for fair probe into charges against teachers

The Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) on Saturday said that it neither accused the Professor of Economics Department A.H.M. Mahbubul Alam nor made demand for his punishment before allegations brought against him were proved.

The DUTA in a statement said that it had proposed temporary suspension of two teachers against whose the academic Committee of Economics department brought accusation of moral deviation, during the investigation for the sake of fair enquiry.

The DUTA demanded punishment to those two teachers after only they found guilty by an enquiry committee which would properly check the allegations. In the statement, the DUTA said that it always took neutral role in all respects.
