DUTA reiterates demand for removal of Bari

Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) at its Executive Committee meeting on Tuesday reiterated its demands for the removal of Mr. M. Ershadul Bari from different bodies of the university including Senate, syndicate and hall administration by August 25.

The meeting held at the University Club with Vice-President Prof Khondaker Nizamuddin in the chair, also demanded formation of a judicial enquiry committee headed by a judge of the Supreme Court to inquire into the August 4 incident.

DUTA also expressed solidarity with the movement of teachers of Journalism Department.

Journalism teachers' sit-in today

Teachers of Dhaka University Journalism Department will stage one hour sit-in from 11 a.m. to 12 noon today (Wednesday) at the Aparajeo Bangla demanding judicial enquiry into the ransacking incident of department offices on August 4 and punishment of the culprits.

The Department Academic Committee took this programme at a meeting on August 13.

Meanwhile, the five-day black badge wearing programme of the department teachers protesting the ransacking rooms of Chairman and seminar and Damage to photocopier and teleprinter machines during the August 4 violence will conclude today (Wednesday).
