Student leaders meet DU V-C

Pledge to keep campus peace

Leaders of major students organisations on Friday assured the Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor to maintain peace in the campuses, including Dhaka Varsity, reports UNB.

They conveyed their agreed decision to Vice Chancellor Prof Ema-juddin Ahmed at a meeting held Friday evening at the latter's office.

The student leaders pledged on behalf of their organisations that the activists of their respective groups will maintain peaceful co-existence in the campus, refrain from creating obstruction in processions and rallies of other groups and indecorous speeches and slogans will also be prevented.

They also pledged that students of different organisations, who are now out of their residential halls will be rehabilitated.

It was decided that all leaders of different organisations will gather today (Saturday) to have tea together at Madhu's Canteen.

The meeting decided that until peace was restored in the DU campus, JCD and BCL will not throw simultaneous programmes.

According to the decision, JCD will bring out a procession in the campus today (Saturday) while BCL will bring out procession on Sunday.

The meeting was attended by JCD President Fazlul Haq Milon and General Secretary Nazimuddin Alam, Chhatra League (M-I) President Moinuddin Hasan Choudhury and Organising Secretary Mahbubul Haq Shakeel, Chhatra League (B-K), President Ruhul Kuddus Babu, Chhatra Moitri President Ragib Ahsan Munna, Chhatra Union
