DU detects 120 fake admission cases

A special Enquiry Team of Dhaka University detected some 120 forged admission cases of M.S.S Preliminary classes of the session 1992-93 during a drive to trace out students who got admitted to different departments by submitting fake papers and

adopting illegal ways.

The enquiry team scrutinised the relevant papers of admission of 120 preliminary classes students of International Relations, Economics Management, Islamic History and Islamic Studies and detected those papers as forged. Necessary punitive measures will be taken against those students immediately, says a member of the team.

The university authorities decided to launch a massive drive to detect forged admission following detection of twelve such cases in Marketing Department. The admissions of those 12 students were cancelled last month.

The three-member enquiry team headed by Commerce Faculty Dean A.B.M. Khaled has been scrutinising the relevant papers of admission of the M.S.S. Preliminary classes students (Session 1992-93) of the six departments under Social Science Faculty.

Such investigation will also be conducted in all department under Commerce and Arts faculties gradually, a member of the team said.
