## DU probe body on abduction of businessman

Dhaka University authorities has formed an inquiry committee on Saturday to investigate into the incident of assaulting a businessman in a room of Mohsin Hall, says a University press release.

The committee was formed on the basis of a news item published in a section of newspapers that one Habibur Rahman along with some terrorists abducted a businessman from Rampura and confined him in room No. 415 of Mohsin Hall. The terrorists beat the businessman and threw him to ground floor from 3rd floor of the hall on Friday.

The press release said that although the hall authorities did not find any clue of such incident, the DU has formed an inquiry committee to dispel any confusion.

President of Chhatra League (S-P) Enamul Hoque Shamim and General Secretary Ishaq Ali Khan Panna in a joint statement on Saturday expressed concern over assaulting a businessman by JCD members at Dhaka University Mohsin Hall and demanded punishment to those responsible for the incident.

In the statement, they alleged that unruly activities by JCD backed terrorists had increased to an alarming proportion. Those terrorists were using Mohsin Hall, Surya Sen Hall, Jasimuddin Hall as their camp but the Dhaka University authorities did not take any measures against them, they alleged.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) will observe token hunger strike in front of the National Press Club today (Sunday) and gherao the Deputy Commissioner office of Dhaka on July 24 demanding release of its Dhaka City Unit President Monzurul Alam Rajib.
