DUTA refutes VC's statement

The Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) on Monday denied the Vice-Chancellor's statement blaming DUTA for advising him to give order regarding the admission of twenty students.

Terming the VC's statement given in a press conference on Sunday as untrue DUTA President Prof. ATM Zahurul Haque and General Secretary Prof. SM Immamul Haq said that such baseless statement not only hampered the image of DUTA but also degraded its dignity in the eye of people.

"The question of giving advice to Vice-Chancellor to apply his administrative power to get twenty students admitted who did not appear at the Admission Tests did not arise because DUTA think that such admission is contrary to traditional admission system of the university" said DUTA leaders in their statement.

"DUTA would stand by its decision and position always to uphold the image and maintain academic atmosphere of the university as it did in the past", they added.

Meanwhile, the General Admission Committee, at an emergency meeting on Monday reviewed the

overall situation arising out of VC's order regarding the admission of twenty students and gave the authority to Academic Council to take final decision on the issue.

The meeting was presided over by Vice-Chancellor Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed. The Academic Committee, which deals with admission affairs, will meet on July 8 to decide the fate of the twenty admission seeking students.
