32 senate members bring corruption charge against VC

Thirty two senate representatives of Dhaka University at a Press conference on Friday accused the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed of resorting to corruption, nepotism and politicalisation of the University Administration and demanded proper enquiry into all irregularities.

Addressing the Press Conference at the university club they raised 13 allegations against the Vice-Chancellor and said that terrorism, corruption, nepotism and irregularities gripped the university administration. They said the Vice-Chancellor implemented resolutions and decisions adopted by Senate and syndicate according to his own will. The Vice-Chancellor was resorting to corruption and nepotism in filling-up different vacancies in the university, they alleged.

The senators accused the Vice-Chancellor of running the DUCSU with non-students and said that no election of DUCSU was held although the term of the present body expired seven years ago.

The senate members called upon the concerned authorities to take measures to hold enquiry into all irregularities of Dhaka University.

They also urged the caretaker government to take necessary measures for recovery of illegal arms and arrest of terrorists from Dhaka University.
