DU exams postponed till Sept 12

There is no sign of solution to the present stalemate of Dhaka University as Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) is still unequivocal to their demands.

The JCD members are still continuing their strike programme in the university in support of their six-point demand. The classes, and administrative activities of the university were not held on Tuesday due to the strike. On the other hand the university authorities postponed all the examinations till September 12 pushing the university towards session jam.

The acting Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof Shahid Uddin Ahmed after taking over the charge

had discussed with different student organisations including Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) but there was no result as the JCD was unequivocal to their demands.

The newly appointed Proctor of Dhaka University Prof Nurunnabi on Tuesday informally met the leaders of JCD at the guest room of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Hall and asked them to sit with VC and other student organisations.

The JCD leaders assured him to sit with VC but they said if their demands were not met they would continue their strike programme.

On the other hand a leader of BCL (S-P) told the Bangladesh Observer that they would not attend any meeting before September 5 by-elections because their leaders were very busy with election purpose.
