

MOU takes effect

DU resident students to be screened today

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which was signed among Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya on Thursday will be effective from today (Sunday) through rehabilitation of the genuine students in their respective dormitories of Dhaka University.

As per MOU, the university authorities directed the hall inmates to stay outside of all the 11 male dormitories by 9 a.m. today (Sunday) for a while and will be allowed to enter their respective halls after verifying their identity cards in presence of hall administration, Proctor and leaders of different student organisations.

Ruling party's student front Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), pro-BNP Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal

(JCD) and Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya, a joint body of eight left-leaning student organisations signed 10-point MOU on Thursday regarding bringing back congenial atmosphere in Dhaka University.

According to the MOU, JCD withdrew its indefinite strike from Saturday that caused suspension of classes and other academic activities and postponement of examinations in Dhaka University.

Meanwhile, acting Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof. Shahid Uddin Ahmed visited Mohsin Hall of the university at about 11.30 a.m. The north gate of the hall which was closed a few days ago has been opened and again shut down in presence of Vice-Chancellor.

prevailing on the campus following an agreement which was signed among JCD, BCL (S-P) and university authorities on Thursday last. He also informed that all administrative activities of the university resumed on Saturday and academic activities will start tomorrow (Monday). He also sought cooperation from all quarters specially student bodies to maintain a congenial academic atmosphere on the campus.
