

DU senate meet adjourned amid pandemonium

The requisition session of the Dhaka University Senate on Monday was adjourned till 5 p.m. today (Tuesday) amid pandemonium, reports BSS.

With Vice-Chancellor Prof. Emazuddin Ahmed in the chair, the session started at 4 p.m. at the university administrative building.

At one stage of heated discussions which turned into a pandemonium the Vice-Chancellor told the senators that he would resign.

Advocate Syed Ahmed, representative of the Senate proposed to form a Senate probe body to investigate into the alleged corruption of the Vice-Chancellor and the university authorities. But the Vice-

Chancellor who is the Senate chairman opposed the formation of the committee saying that there was no scope to form it under the University Ordinance 1973. Advocate Wzaer Earuk said that Vice-Chancellor can form a probe body under the Article 57 of the University Ordinance.

The Vice-Chancellor said that the allegations against the university authorities must be specific.

Some of the senators including Prof. A. K. Azad Chowdhury, Prof. Sahadat Ali and Prof. Anwarullah Chowdhury said that there were specific allegations against the VC and the university authorities.

The Vice-Chancellor adjourned the session till today (Tuesday).
