

## DUTA concern over campus situation

The Executive Committee of the Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) on Sunday expressed concern over the deterioration of campus situation and called upon all section to extend cooperation to the university authorities in bringing back congenial atmosphere on the campus.

Chaired by DUTA President Prof. A.T.M. Zahurul Haq the meeting in a resolution said that the announcement of resignation issue of some provosts by Vice-Chancellor Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed was unexpected.

### No Acting-VC yet

The Government did not name anyone as acting Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University till Sunday after the resignation of Vice-Chancellor Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed on Saturday. Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed resigned as the Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University amid violence and restive situation on the campus. Appointed in 1992 his tenure as Vice-Chancellor was to be over within a few months.

The Vice-Chancellor before resignation declared closure of the university till August 29. Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed earlier on Thursday threatened to resign if the five halls were not freed from the terrorists. Ruling party backed Chhatra League occupied the halls on Thursday which had so long been under the control of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal, the student wing of BNP.

Provosts of seven halls also resigned en masse on Saturday blaming the government for failing to restore law and order on the campus and in the halls.
