DU women's halls raided

Women unit of Dhaka Metropolitan police raided two women's halls and an annexe building of a hall of Dhaka University on Tuesday morning and returned empty handed.

During the four-hour raid nobody was however arrested.

A strong contingent of police cordoned off Shamsunnahar Hall, Rokeya Hall and Nawab Faijunnesa Dormitory, an annexe building of Shamsunnahar Hall at about 8.30 a.m. and continued their drive till 12.30 p.m. Women police conducted raid inside the halls.

Meanwhile, the women supporters of ruling party's student front Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and pro-BNP Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) locked in quarrel centring entrance of two members of Detective Branch of police inside Shamsunnahar Hall.

A group of students of the hall reportedly supporters of JCD resisted the entrance of police on the other hand another group belonging to Bangladesh Chhatra League welcomed them.
