



DU Hons admission

61000 candidates for 4404 seats

A total of 61 thousand one hundred and 80 students have applied against 4404 seats for admission into first year Honours courses under different faculties of Dhaka University this year. The last date for submission of application forms for admission was Thursday (April 10).

Twenty one thousand, four hundred and 80 applications have been submitted against 1100 seats of science faculty (Ka unit), 15 thousand and one hundred applications against 2000 seats of arts faculty (Kha unit), nine thousand and nine hundred applications against 704 seats of business studies faculty (Ga unit) and 14 thousand and nine hundred applications against 600 seats of (Gha unit), a combination of all the faculties.

This year on an average 14 students will compete for one seat in the admission test of first year honours (session 1996-1997) examination. On the other hand, 19 students will compete for a seat of "Ka unit", 7.50 students for a seat of "Kha unit", 14 students for a seat of "Ga unit"

24 students will compete for a seat of "Gha unit".

The number of applicants is about 10,000 less than last year due to low percentage of pass in H.S.C. examination which was held in 1996. About 71,000 applications were submitted for about 4000 seats for admission into 1st year honours courses under different faculties of Dhaka University last year.

Meanwhile, Dhaka University authorities have already announced the dates for admission test. The examinations will begin from May 2.
